

TICKETS

One-Way tickets are sold on board trains and are available at New Haven's Union Station, Old Saybrook and New London Amtrak ticket windows.

Ten-Trip tickets are only sold at New Haven's Union Station, Old Saybrook and New London Amtrak ticket windows.

Monthly tickets are sold by mail, phone, web and are available at New Haven's Union Station, Old Saybrook and New London Amtrak ticket windows. Ticket information is available through ShoreLineEast.com or by calling 800.ALL.RIDE.

Monthly Plus includes Shore Line East and CTRANSIT Commuter Connection bus service in New Haven, Bridgeport and Stamford. These tickets are sold by mail, phone 800.ALL.RIDE and at the Amtrak ticket windows in New Haven's Union Station, Old Saybrook and New London.

Children up to age 11 may travel for free with a Shore Line East fare paying adult (limit four children traveling free) on both weekdays and weekends. Additional children will be charged the adult fare. Shore Line East's 'Child Fare Policy' does not apply to Amtrak service to/from New London and Old Saybrook.

UniRail tickets combine Shore Line East and New Haven Line rail fares into one convenient ticket (one-way, weekly, monthly). A Uniticket can be purchased for a combined Metro-North New Haven Line with bus service to Bridgeport and Stamford and are available at Metro-North ticket windows and Metro-North ticket vending machines. Only monthly Unirail tickets are available on the web or by mail-in. Ticket information is available through mta.info or 212.532.4900.

SLE operates **year-round weekday, weekend and holiday service** between New Haven's Union Station and Old Saybrook.

Your guide to riding Shore Line East trains.



SERVICE EVERY DAY.

The Connecticut Department of Transportation's Shore Line East Rail Service operates seven days a week, including holidays between Old Saybrook and New Haven. Limited weekday service is available to New London.

Plus, with Shore Line East Express, there is now weekday one-train, one-seat express service to and from Bridgeport and Stamford.

Connections to the New Haven Line and Amtrak service are available at New Haven's Union Station.

Go Easy.

Shore Line East operates peak hour morning and afternoon/evening trains every day - including holidays. Plus, with Shore Line East Stamford Express, there are two morning and two evening weekday trains, with one-seat express service to and from Bridgeport and Stamford.

Go Park.

Free parking is available at all Shore Line East train stations except New London and New Haven. Parking is not available at State Street Station. All trains and stations are handicapped accessible.

If you transfer in New Haven, most connecting New Haven Line trains at Union Station have you on your way in less than ten minutes!

Passengers transferring may buy their New Haven Line ticket on-board without paying the surcharge. Just show the Metro-North conductor your Shore Line East ticket when making your purchase.

Passengers returning to Shore Line East on the New Haven Line should purchase their New Haven Line tickets before boarding the train to avoid paying an additional surcharge.

If you are traveling west of New Haven on the New Haven Line, walk across the platform (in most cases) and board the waiting New Haven Line train for travel to your final destination. Shore Line East train conductors always know where your connecting New Haven Line train will be waiting, so feel free to ask.

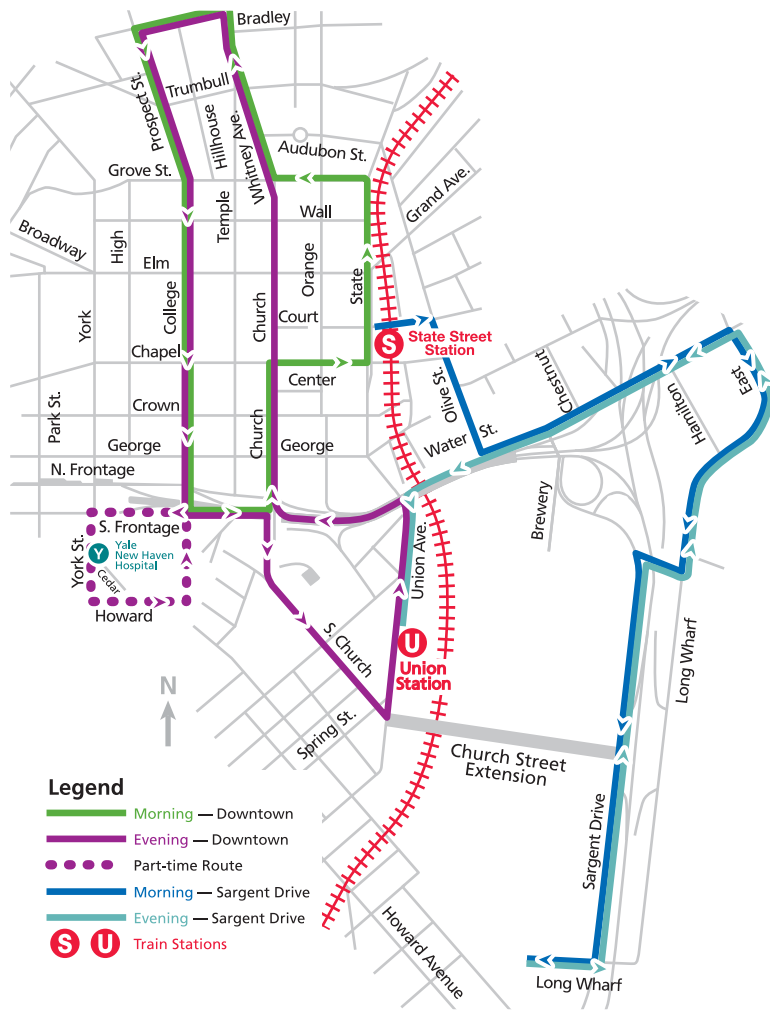
WE'VE GOT THE RIGHT CONNECTIONS.

Commuter Connection buses eliminate the worry of getting between the train station and the office, making Shore Line East even easier and more convenient.

Weekday mornings, buses wait right in front of State Street Station. A few minutes after each train arrives, the buses depart and loop through downtown New Haven and the Sargent Drive/Long Wharf area.

Weekday evenings, buses begin their loop through downtown New Haven and the Sargent Drive/Long Wharf area approximately 20 minutes before Shore Line East departure times. Passengers arrive at Union Station about 5 minutes before Shore Line East departures. Please note that if a shuttle bus gets to Union Station late, the Shore Line East train will wait. If you're continuing your commute past New Haven, buses connect at these stations:

Milford

The Milford Transit District provides shuttle service to Milford and Orange. For route and schedule information, call 203.874.4507.

Stratford/Bridgeport/Fairfield

The Stratford Commuter Connection shuttle bus provides weekday bus service to and from the Stratford Railroad Station. The Greater Bridgeport Transit Authority provides bus connections to Bridgeport, Fairfield and Trumbull. For route and schedule information, call 203.333.3031.

Norwalk

The Norwalk Commuter Connection travels between the South Norwalk train station and work sites north of the Merritt Parkway along Route 7. Other local bus routes provide service from South Norwalk and East Norwalk along Connecticut Avenue (Route 1). For information, call 203.852.0000.

Stamford

The Stamford Commuter Connection shuttle bus and other local bus routes provide convenient travel between the train station and employer sites in downtown Stamford and to location north and south of downtown. For route and schedule information, call CTransit at 203.327.7433.

Greenwich

The Greenwich Commuter Connection shuttle buses operate between the train station and employment sites in Greenwich. For more information, call 800.982.8420.

STATION LOCATIONS

New Haven – Union Station

50 Union Avenue, New Haven, CT 06519

I-91: Exit 1

I-95: Exit 47

Take the Route 34 extension. Follow to the first exit - Downtown New Haven. Make the hard (180 degree) right turn immediately, go to the light and turn right onto Union Avenue. The train station (and parking) are two blocks ahead on the left.

New Haven – State Street

370 State Street, New Haven, CT 06510

I-95 South: Exit 47

I-91 North: Exit 1

Take the Route 34 extension. Follow to the first exit - Downtown New Haven. Stay straight to go onto N. Frontage Road to Church Street. Turn right onto Church Street. Go 4 blocks and turn right on to Chapel Street. Go 2 blocks to State Street and turn left. State Street Railroad Station will be on the right.

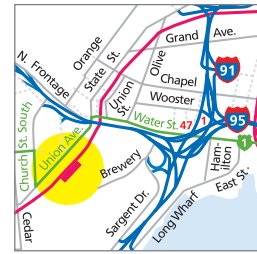
Branford

39 Maple Street, Branford, CT 06405

I-95 South: Exit 54 - turn left.

I-95 North: Exit 54 - turn right.

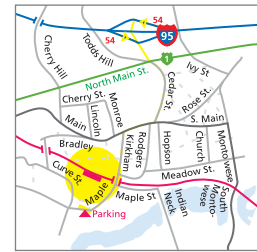
Proceed straight at intersection (N. Main Street) continuing to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street. Proceed to first light (Kirkham Street) and turn left. Proceed to stop sign (Meadow Street) and proceed straight over the train tracks and go straight, while looking for the parking lot entrance on your right.



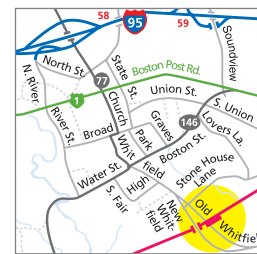

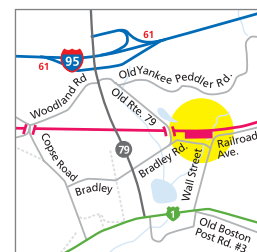
New Haven - State Street



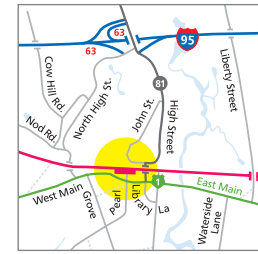

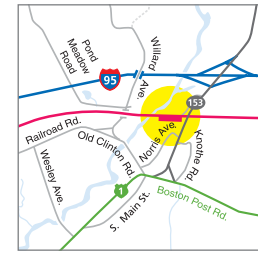

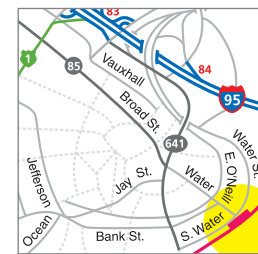

Guilford

325 Old Whitfield Street, Guilford, CT 06437

I-95 South: Exit 58 - turn left.

I-95 North: Exit 58 - turn right.

Proceed south on Route 77 to the Guilford Green. Turn right (onto Broad Street), then take the first left (onto Whitfield Street). Go past Route 146 and bear right (name changes to New Whitfield Street). Cross over the train tracks, take first left (Pages Lane). Go to stop sign and turn left again. The train station is straight ahead.

Madison

79 Bradley Road, Madison, CT 06443

I-95 South: Exit 61 - turn left.

I-95 North: Exit 61 - turn right.

Take Route 79 south to Bradley Road and turn left. Train station is on the left. From Route 1: Take Route 79 North to Bradley Road and turn right. The train station is on the left.

Clinton

10 John Street Extension, Clinton, CT 06413

I-95 North: Exit 63 - turn left at end of ramp, then right.

I-95 South: Exit 63 - turn right.

Take Route 81 South to Route 1. Turn right onto Route 1, take the next right onto John Street Extension. Station is straight ahead. From Route 1: Turn north onto John Street Extension (just west of Route 81).

Westbrook

119 Essex Road, Westbrook, CT 06498

I-95 South: Exit 65 - turn left.

I-95 North: Exit 65 - turn right.

Take Essex Road (Route 153 south). After you go over the highway bridge over the train tracks, turn right onto Norris Avenue #1. Turn right at the Westbrook maintenance garage. Parking lot is on the left. From Route 1: Head north on Essex Road (Route 153). Turn right onto Norris Avenue #1. Turn right at the Westbrook maintenance garage. The parking lot is on the left side.

Old Saybrook

3 North Main Street, Old Saybrook, CT 06475

I-95 South: Exit 68 - onto Route 1. Turn left at the first light, and on the far side of the overpass turn right immediately into the Saybrook Junction Market Place. Station is in the rear to the left of the stores.

I-95 North: Exit 67 - Veer right. Go through first traffic light and on the far side of the overpass turn right immediately into the Saybrook Junction Market Place. Station is in the rear to the left of the stores.

New London

27 Water Street, New London, CT 06320

I-95 South: Exit 84 - Left off ramp onto Route 32 south and follow Eugene O'Neill Drive. Turn left onto State Street. Parking: Turn left from State Street onto Water Street. Municipal garage is on your left.

I-95 North: Exit 83 - Go straight off exit and cross over Route 32 to Huntington Street (Route 641). Turn left onto Bank Street. Right onto State Street. Parking: Turn left from State Street onto Water Street. Municipal garage is on your left.

I-395 South: Exit 78 - to Route 32 south and follow Eugene O'Neill Drive. Turn left onto State Street. Parking: Turn left from State Street onto Water Street. Municipal garage is on your left.
